STAGE 2: Individual Shows (Young Judges will NOT ride exhibits).

STAGE 3: Conformation (Groups of 2/3 - grid formation). Each group of young judges gets 3 minutes to look around the animal, this is timed.

STAGE 4: Show interview with the 2 panel judges who were also judging the class.

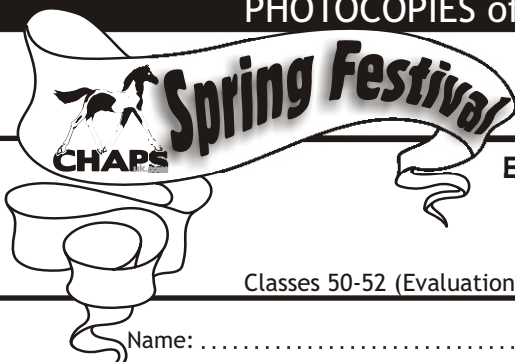
