## Rules & Conditions of Entry

**Where the term "Members Handbook" is used, this refers to the current CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook plus any relevant updates which may have been issued.**

- 1 This Show is affiliated to the Coloured Horse & Pony Society (UK). Both owner and the rider/exhibitor need not be a member of CHAPS (UK) nor must the horse or pony be registered with CHAPS (UK) to compete, but in order to qualify they must both be Showing Members and the horse/pony must be Registered with the Society BEFORE this show for the qualification to be valid (except Ponies (UK)/BSPS qualifiers where Membership and Registration, if not already in place, MUST be made within 14 days of qualification for qualification to be valid). See Members' Handbook or [www.chapsuk.com](http://www.chapsuk.com) for rulings.  
**The CHAPS (UK) Championship Show will be held on 3rd-5th September 2010 at Arena UK, Grantham. Members to apply in writing to CHAPS (UK) for 2010 CHAPS qualifier card. Ponies (UK) Summer Championships will be held 11th-14th Aug 2010. BSPS Winter Champs, 2011.**
- 2 Please refer to current Members' Handbook or [www.chapsuk.com](http://www.chapsuk.com) for full rulings on all qualifiers.
- 3 The ruling of Judges and Officials is Final. CHAPS (UK) reserves the right to substitute judges.
- 4 Full and correct attire must be worn by all competitors and their grooms. Hard hats must be worn whilst mounted on any part of the Showground. Grooms must wear suitable hats whilst attending in the Ring. All Junior Exhibitors (under 18 years on 1st January of the current year) MUST wear correctly fitting current safety standard hats. **ALL riders at the Northern Regional must wear correctly fitted hats which conform to current BHS standards.**
- 5 The Organisers reserve the right to amalgamate or alter any class(es) or ring(s) without explanation.
- 6 All dogs must be kept on leads at all times.
- 7 Neither the Organisers, Landowners, Committee or Agents of this Society accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, riders, spectators, land or any person or property whatsoever, whether caused by negligence, breach of contract or in any way whatsoever.
- 8 No Exhibitor (rider or handler) should knowingly exhibit an animal under a Panel Judge who has owned, bred, produced, leased/loaned, sold or received any financial gain from that exhibit (horse/pony) with the exception of ancillary services i.e. Stud fees, group teachings, vet, blacksmith etc.
- 9 **No horse/pony under the age of 4 years may be ridden on the showground.**  
No galloping is allowed on the Showground except as required by the Judge.
- 10 Any person participating in any way at this Show who conducts themselves in a manner which might bring the Society into disrepute will be asked to leave the Showground.
- 11 All Classes will be as listed below unless otherwise stated: **In-hand classes** will be judged 60% conformation, correctness to type and movement; 40% manners and way of going. **Ridden Classes** will be judged 50% ride, manners and way of going; 50% type and conformation. **Junior Ridden Qualifiers** (as per Members' Handbook) 60% Ride, Manners, Temperament, Suitability & Partnership; 40% Type and Conformation. **HOYS classes** will be judged as per mark sheet system.
- 12 Exhibitors shall take good care of, and shall not cause any damage or suffer any damage to be done to the site/Showground or to any furniture, fittings, equipment or other property therein and shall be responsible to pay for any damage thereto (including accidental damage) caused by any act or neglect in use. This includes stabling.
- 13 Horse walks must be adhered to. Pedestrians should not walk in the horse walks.
- 14 All horses/ponies attending are advised to hold current vaccination certificates.
- 15 No mucking out of lorries/trailers allowed on show ground.
- 16 Any complaint must be made in accordance to regulations within the CHAPS (UK) Members' Handbook.
- 17 NO refund of entry fees without a vet or doctor's certificate, then a 50% refund only is applicable.  
In the event of cancellation of any Show, refunds will be made less a 25% administration fee.
- 18 Entry into any CHAPS Regional Show is deemed acceptance to be bound by CHAPS Rules and those of the Show.

### Youngstock Evaluations

Commencing 9.00am Prompt

The Youngstock Evaluations are aimed towards potential breeding stock – colts and fillies. The classes are open to coloured exhibits which are CHAPS (UK) Registered prior to entry. Owners/Exhibitors must be current CHAPS (UK) Showing Members.

Premiums are awarded as follows: FIRST PREMIUM, 8 marks or above; SECOND PREMIUM, 7.5 to 7.999 marks; THIRD PREMIUM, 7.0 to 7.499. Scores below 7.0 are not awarded any Premium. Exhibits will be judged individually and on their own merits entirely.

**Please state age of exhibit on entry form and include breeding where known.**

**Entry into the Evaluations is deemed acceptance of all pertaining CHAPS (UK) Rules.**

Class 9 **Non-Native Horse Youngstock Evaluation.** Filly or colt, exc or expected to exc 153cms at maturity. Yearling, 2 Year Old or 3 Year Old.

Class 10 **Native, Cob, Traditional, Show Cob, Vanner Youngstock Evaluation.** Filly or colt, open height. Yearling, 2 Year Old or 3 Year Old.

Class 11 **Non-Native Pony Youngstock Evaluation.** Filly or colt, not exc or not expected to exc 153cms at maturity. Yearling, 2 Year Old or 3 Year Old.

**Championship.** All First Premium exhibits from the day are invited to compete on conclusion of class 11.

Class 12 **Yearling.** Open to Non-Native and Nat/Cob/Trad type exhibits born in 2009.

Class 13 **2 Year Old.** Open to Non-Native and Nat/Cob/Trad type exhibits born in 2008.

Class 14 **3 Year Old.** Open to Non-Native and Nat/Cob/Trad type exhibits born in 2007.

**Championship** 1st and 2nd placed exhibits from classes 12-14 to compete. Champion & Reserve to compete for Supreme In-hand.

### CHAPS (UK) In-hand Qualifiers

Classes 15-19 are qualifiers for the CHAPS (UK) Championship Show In-hand Finals and the P(UK) Summer Championships (Clarendon Coloureds CHAPS (UK) In-hand Final 2010). The highest placed Non-Native type exhibit and the highest placed Nat/Cob/Trad type exhibit, not already qualified, from the class placings in each class will qualify.

The highest placed eligible Sporthorse/Pony from classes 15, 18 & 19 will qualify for the Sporthorse/Pony Final at the CHAPS (UK) Championship Show 2010.

Class 15 **In-hand Non-Native Pony.** Not exceeding or likely to exceed 153cms (15.0hh).

Class 16 **In-hand Native/Cob/Traditional/Show Cob Pony.** Not exceeding or likely to exceed 148cms (14.2hh) and under.

Class 17 **In-hand Native/Cob/Traditional/Show Cob Horse.** Exceeding or likely to exceed 148cms (14.2hh).

Class 18 **In-hand Non-Native Horse.** Exceeding or likely to exceed 153cms (15.0hh).

Class 19 **Sports Horse/Pony & Warmblood.** Open height.

**Championship** 1st and 2nd placed exhibits from classes 15-19 to compete. Champion & Reserve to compete for Supreme In-hand.

## Ring THREE

*Classes 20-25, please refer to Members' Handbook for full rulings on all qualifications. Class 20 is optional ridden or in-hand; classes 21-25 are ridden; classes 26-28 are in-hand.*

*Classes 22 & 23 are qualifiers for the CHAPS UK Finals at P(UK) Summer Champs 2010 or 2011 as relevant. The highest placed Non-Native and highest placed Nat/Cob/Trad/Vanner type exhibits, not already qualified, from within the class placings will qualify.*

- Class 20 Veteran, Ridden or In-hand CHAPS Qualifier.** Qualification will be awarded to highest placed exhibits in following categories: 15-19yrs; 20-29yrs; 30+yrs.
- Class 21 Lead Rein/First Ridden Pony CHAPS (UK) Qualifier.** LR 3-8yrs, exhibits not to exc 122cms; FR 10yrs and under, exhibits not to exc 128cms.
- Class 22 My Little Nutmeg Novice Ridden Pony Qualifier.** Non-Native exhibits not exc 153cms; Nat/Cob/Trad exhibits not exc 148cms. Any suitable bridle.
- Class 23 Back to Black Novice Ridden Horse Qualifier.** Non-Native exhibits exc 153cms; Nat/Cob/Trad exhibits exc 148cms. Any suitable bridle.
- Class 24 The CHAPS Factor Qualifier.** Open to competitors and exhibits (CHAPS Registered and Showing Member owned/ridden) who have not previously qualified for HOYS or been placed in the top 3 in any CHAPS (UK) Ridden Final (excluding LR and FR). The two highest placed eligible exhibits who have not already done so, will qualify, from class placings.
- Class 25 Coloured Contacts Junior Ridden CHAPS (UK) Qualifier.** Open to any type of exhibit. The class will be judged as one section; however TWO qualifiers will be awarded. One to the highest placed exhibit not exceeding 138cms (riders to be 14 years or under); and one to the highest placed exhibits not exceeding 153cms (riders under 18 years). Class to include a cross pole fence.
- Class 26 Young Handler.** Exhibitors 16 years and under, exhibits suitable height for age/size of handler, no colts or stallions. May be split if entries warrant.
- Class 27 In-hand Show Type** (e.g. Riding Horse, Hack, Show Pony, Show Hunter P) open height.
- Class 28 In-hand Native, Trad, Show Cob or Vanner.** Open height.
- Championship** 1st and 2nd placed exhibits from classes 20-28 to compete. Champion & Reserve to compete for Ridden or In-hand Supreme as relevant

### **How to find PACHESHAM EQUESTRIAN CENTRE**

**From M25:** Take Junction 9 to Esher. Turn left at the roundabout into Oaklawn Road. Turn left at the end of the road onto A245, Pachesham EC is first on the left.

**From A3:** Leave at Junction for Esher Common onto A244 to Leatherhead. Travel for approx 2 miles through Oxshot village. Go right at the roundabout into Oaklawn Road, Pachesham EC is first of the left.

**From A24:** Go into Leatherhead and follow one way system. Turn left in front of railway station onto A245 towards Cobham. Pachesham EC is 1 mile on the right.

### **How to find RICHMOND EQUESTRIAN CENTRE**

**All riders must wear correctly fitted hats which conform to current BHS standards.**

**From the South:** From the A1 south take the slip road turn off for Richmond, Catterick, Hackforth and Tunstall (A6136). At the end of the slip road turn left then first right, both junctions are marked with brown TOURIST signs). At the next junction turn left to TUNSTALL, before entering the village take the first right turn after the 30mph sign. The REC is approx 1 mile up this road on the left.

**From the North:** From the A1 north take the 2nd slip road for Richmond, Catterick, Hackforth and Tunstall (A6136). Take the first left turn travelling over the A1. Over the A1 take the first right turn to Tunstall and then left at the T junction, both marked with brown tourist signs. Before entering the village take the first right turn after the 30mph sign. The REC is approx 1 mile up this road on the left.

### **How to find BRYNAGROG HALL FARM SHOWGROUND**

**From North:** From M53 (Chester) continue onto A55. Take J36 onto the A483 signposted Wrexham/Chester. At roundabout take 1st turning left onto A483 signpost Wrexham. Exit at J2 (stay in left hand lane) signposted Bangor on Dee and The Plassey onto the B5426. Continue on the B5426 (traffic calming) to cross roads. Turn left onto A528 and continue to T-junction (church should be in front of you). Turn left onto A525 heading for Wrexham, Bryn y Grog is approx 1 mile on the left hand side.

**From South:** From A5 (Oswestry) continue onto A483. Exit at J2 (stay in right hand lane) signpost Bangor on Dee and The Plassey onto the B5426. At next roundabout take the third exit (4029 to Bulkington); go over the mini roundabout, past the railway station and school on the left, over speed humps – Weston Lawns is on your right.
