Entries made to any Final(s) class which is/are not supported by a valid CHAPS UK Qualification Card Number, and, where appropriate, CHAPS UK Affiliated Show Number, will not be accepted. At least one eligible class from each of the above Sections **MUST** be entered.

Points can only be accumulated from **1 class per Section (3 classes in total).**

POINTS CARDS are available to purchase from the Secretary's Office (on the first day of the Show) OR pre-ordered via the online entry system at £20.00 each.

Points accumulated as follows: 1st - 6pts; 2nd, 5pts; 3rd, 4pts; 4th, 3pts; 5th, 2pts; 6th, 1pt.

You may play a **JOKER** on **ONE** class (per Card) which will **DOUBLE** the points earned in that class; however, you **MUST** indicate which class you will play your Joker in **at the time of collecting your Accumulator Card** (the Show Office staff will make a note of this on your Accumulator Card).
You should fill in your results for relevant classes and total-up your sheets prior to handing in at the Show Office.

Competition Cards are £15 each and are available to pre-book via the on-line entry system or from the Show Office BEFORE your first relevant class.

Points can be accrued from all classes at the show **which are scheduled before 4.00pm on the last day of the current year's Show** - with the exception of any **FINALS** class(es).

At time of collecting your Card you must pre-select three classes from across the show - covering a minimum of 2 days' of competition; and you must also pre-select one of these as a "Joker" class - points from results in this class will automatically double towards your total. Points will be awarded as follows: 1st 15 points; 2nd 10 points; 3rd 7 points; 4th 5 points; 5th 3 points; 6th 1 points.

In the event of a tie the Joker will be removed and points re-totalled. If points still tie then the exhibit achieving most "higher placings" will be deemed the winner. If no clear winner is achieved via this system any relevant championship results from selected classes will be considered. If no clear winner is achieved via this route a tie will be declared for that placing.

Completed points cards MUST be handed in at the Show Office BEFORE 4.00pm on the last day of the current year's Show. Late Cards will be declared null and void.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Full **Show Rules and Conditions of Entry** can be downloaded at www.chapsuk.com

Classes prefixed “Q” are qualifiers for the relevant Final(s) at the 2026 CHAPS UK Championship Show; and, where appropriate for their relevant Final(s) at this Show.

NB: where qualification is gained in a Youngstock/Sports Youngstock/Veteran class for the following year’s show, the qualification will pass forward to the relevant age category; 3 year old qualifications will pass to the relevant type/height In-hand Final. Veteran/Sport Horse or Pony [4 years or over] classes will also offer qualification for the relevant In-hand Final).

Veteran ridden/in-hand classes qualification will be awarded to both the highest placed In-hand and Ridden Non-Native and Native/Cob/Traditional exhibits.

Veteran Finals classes will offer qualification for Veteran Finals in the following age groups: highest placed - 15-24 years; 25+ years (from within the class placings).

Classes prefixed “F” are Finals classes and require pre-qualification at either a CHAPS UK Regional or Affiliated Show, or the CHAPS UK Championship Show - see Rule 25.

Classes marked ** will be ridden by the judge.

Exhibits in all Ridden Classes must be 4 years old or over.

In-hand classes are open to any age exhibit (no weaned foals) unless an age is stated in the class title.

Exhibit Heights. Unless stated, classes will be open to any height exhibit.

Exhibit Type. Unless stated, classes will be open to any type.

Height Certificates. Please refer to current CHAPS UK Members’ Handbook and CHAPS UK Championship Show Rules and Conditions of Entry for rulings on height certificates.

Finalist Rosettes. All exhibits in CHAPS UK Finals classes will receive a Finalist Rosette.

Preliminary Judging. Where preliminary judging takes place in any Finals section classes the exhibits required to go forward to the final judging stage will be posted (in no particular order) in the Show Office.

Championships. Where a section Championship states “1st & 2nd prizewinners to compete”, this refers only to the classes in the section directly above that Championship heading.

Traditional or Native classes. Where a class is designated as either Traditional or Native (not a combined class), exhibits may only compete in one section.

Show Production. All exhibits to be shown according to standards for their respective breed type.

Complaints. Must be lodged with 45 minutes of incident; a fee of £65 to be paid which will be refunded if the complaint is upheld.

Insurance statement: It is strongly recommended that all exhibitors carry PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE for an adequate indemnity to protect against their negligence.

Any entry made for the Show is deemed as acceptance by the exhibitor, rider and/or handler, owner, and all related parties (grooms, helpers etc) to agree to abide by the Rules and Conditions of CHAPS UK and this Show.

Colourama Riding Club Championship. The Colourama Championship will run under CHAPS UK Rules (please see the Members’ Handbook). Competitors must have proof of Riding Club membership to compete. Horses, ponies and/or riders not to have qualified for HOYS in 2024, 2025 or 2026. Eligible competitors must collect a Riding Club Competition Card from the CHAPS UK Show Office (prior to your class(es)) and make themselves known to the stewards at the time of placings during your class(es). Championships will take place at the end of each day and a Supreme on the final night.

Height of exhibits - Riders should be a suitable height and weight for the exhibits they ride.

CLASHING of CLASSES: Every effort has been made to avoid classes clashing, but *if an exhibitor finds their classes overlap, it is suggested permission be obtained from the Steward and Judge to give individual shows, ridden or in-hand, early in classes and then move to another ring*; however, exhibits will not be placed unless they (or a representative) are present for final presentation of awards. Classes may not be held up for missing competitors. ***Exhibitors are reminded to consider clashing of either horse/pony or rider/handler BEFORE entering. NO REFUNDS WILL BE MADE FOR ANY MISSED OR CLASHED CLASSES. Whilst we have tried to give class times, the stated times are a guideline only.*** DAYTIME CLASSES will not run before the stated times, but may run later. EVENING PERFORMANCES may run either a little earlier or later than stated; but the start time for Evening Performances will not be earlier than stated.

HORSE WALKS: MUST BE ADHERED TO. PEDESTRIANS SHOULD NOT WALK IN, OR CROSS, THE HORSE WALKS.

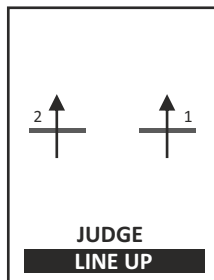

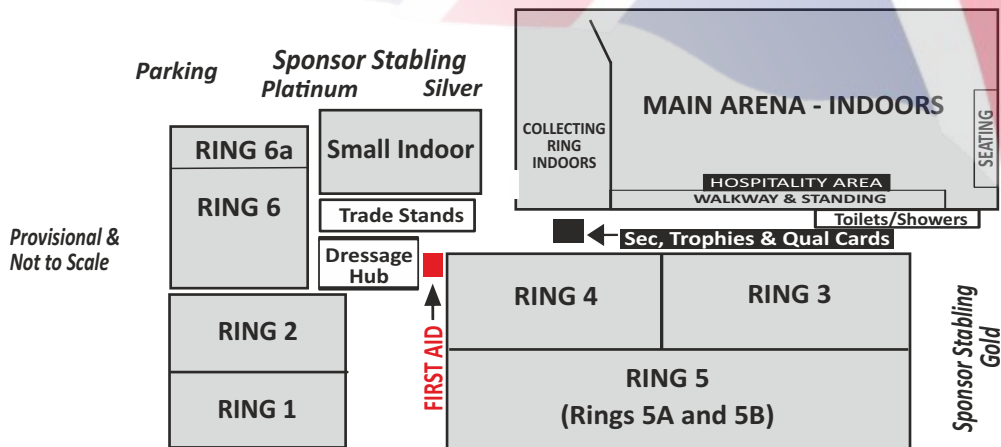
